

# Promoting Growth Every Day

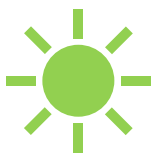
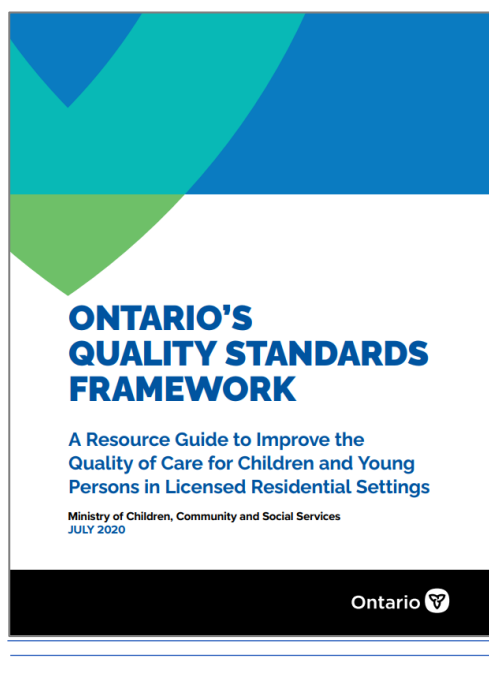
